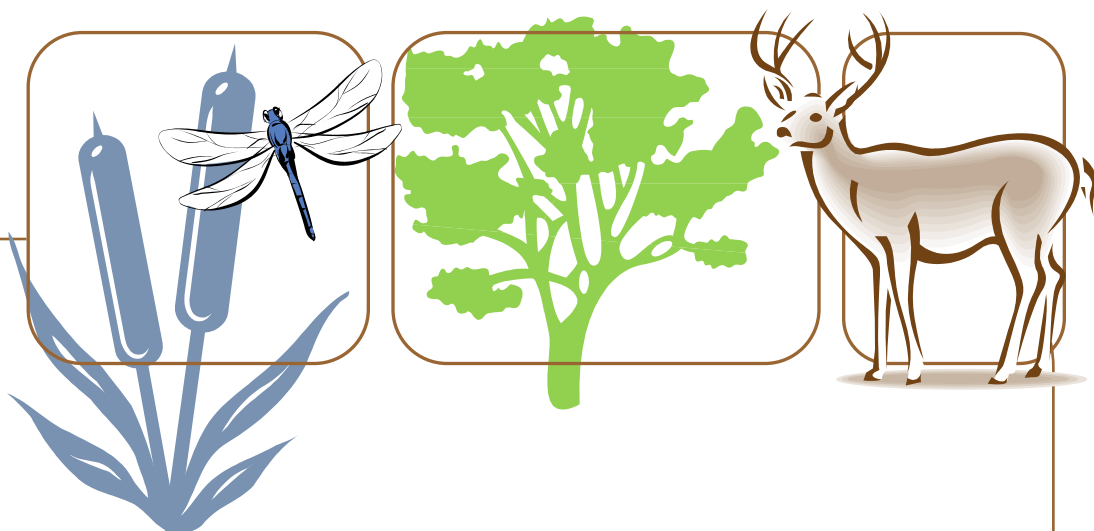


2016 Pymatuning/Shenango Watershed Challenge
