

Wildlife Station Outline - 2018

The 2018 Pymatuning/Shenango Watershed Challenge Wildlife Station will emphasize Habitat Management / Enhancement projects (artificial nest boxes & devices, food plots, warm season grasses, border cuts, early successional cutting, prescribed burning, etc.) & the wildlife species that benefit directly from those practices.

Wildlife Notes (and particular species) for study packets could include pheasants, rabbits, grouse, squirrels, woodcock, wood ducks, mallards, Canada goose, barn owls, screech owls, kestrel, bluebirds, & all other cavity nesting birds; as well as turkey, deer and a variety of other wildlife including furbearers and songbirds.

Whether done on small scale (homeowner), family farm, or State Game Lands habitat enhancements can benefit a variety of wildlife.
